

Mark Freeman Memorial Scholarship Award Application Form

Background

Mark Freeman was a 1979 graduate of Coudersport Area Jr/Sr High School who excelled in football and track. After high school he served his community at Cole Care a subsidiary of UPMC Cole, for over 35 years; many of which he served as Director of Operations. He was heavily engaged in his community coaching various youth sports, volunteering as Assistant Scout Master, Denton Hill Ski Patrol and serving as a Homer Township Supervisor. He also volunteered with Coudersport Sports Boosters, serving as President. In his spare time, he enjoyed attending his sons many events, spending time with family and friends, working on the family farm and producing maple syrup. He left a legacy of leadership and strong work ethic that the scholarship committee wishes to recognize in graduating students.

The purpose of the Mark Freeman Memorial Scholarship is to provide scholarship awards to students who have shown a career interest in trades, healthcare, business or agriculture. The scholarship has been created to honor Mark's life and to recognize the academic and community achievements of students at Coudersport Area Jr. Sr. High School.

Awards

One scholarship award is available in the amount of \$750 annually. The scholarship award will be paid directly to the recipient.

Eligibility

1. Applicants must be accepted into a form of post high school education to include trade school, community college or university.
2. Applicants may be pursuing majors in any field of study but priority will be given to those students pursuing a trade or majoring in healthcare, business, or agriculture.
3. Applicants must be in good academic standing.
4. Applicants must demonstrate a strong work ethic and leadership potential in school and/or the community.

Selection Criteria

1. Demonstrated leadership capabilities in sports, and/or school and/or community engagements.
2. Student essay
3. Academic standing

Application Requirements

To be considered for The Mark Freeman Memorial Scholarship, applicants must complete an application and return it to Student Services by April 21st. The application must include:

1. A completed application form. *Only completed application forms will be considered.*
2. A one page (< 500 words) statement stating the applicant's qualifications and educational and career goals.

Both of the above items must be submitted before the application will be considered.
